1. The City of Jerseyville, its employees, volunteers and other members will not be held responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items or equipment while on premises for the BBQ, Brews, and Bluegrass Family Festival.
2. This Event will be held Rain or Shine (No Refunds will be given).
3. All vendors must be set up by 5:00pm on the 1st or 9am on Saturday June 2nd.
4. Spaces will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. Spaces are on concrete parking, streets and Grass boulevards throughout the park. This is a natural environment and will not be level in most cases.
5. Please use the notes section on the page 2 to describe any special needs for maneuvering your trailers. We will try to accommodate as best we can. All trailers should be taken to the designated parking area after being setup. You will be asked to move if you are found in another lot or side street.
6. You will be required to stay in your spot for the duration of the festival each day. Leaving early will not be allowed and will result in your invitation being revoked for future events.
7. This is a sanctioned event through the St. Louis BBQ Society and all rules must be followed.
8. The General Public will be allowed on site officially from 6-11pm Friday and 9am-11pm Saturday.
9. If your booth involves the sale of food, prior notification is necessary to the committee and approval will have to be granted. We are obligated to follow the stipulations and rules of the St. Louis BBQ Society, which include what is served at a Sanctioned Event.
